The Municipality of the County of Richmond is currently accepting applications for the position of Returning Officer for the upcoming 2024 Municipal Election.

A Municipal Returning Officer (RO) is responsible for the delivery and control of municipal electoral events and school board electoral events within the Municipality, in accordance with the Nova Scotia Municipal Elections Act and Nova Scotia Education Act. This role requires a range of duties, including but not limited to, serving as the primary contact for election related inquiries, receiving nominations, organizing the polls, hiring and training Election Workers, ensuring accurate counts in compliance with all regulations and requirements, and works within the established budget. Hours will be irregular, part time leading up to the election, with most of the hours taking place in September and October.

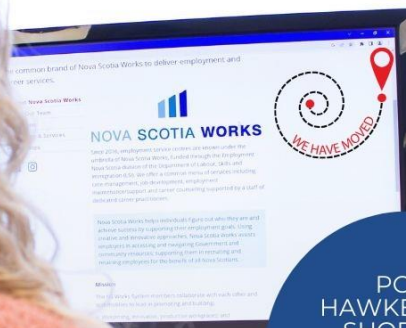
